To Whom it may concern:

My name is Michael Peña and I own and operate ImmunoSolutions, Inc. a consulting and training company that trains military and other governmental teams that are chartered to execute specialized missions worldwide related to chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive material (CBRNE). ImmunoSolutions specializes in the biological discipline and trains team on what they may see in biological production facilities. We then train them on site characterization, site sampling and interdiction strategies. Having been deployed with units such as these I noticed the lack of experience by soldiers in the biological sciences. For example; teams that I trained with that went into Iraq visited chemical plants as part of their pre-deployment training but did not visit any biological research or production facilities.

ImmunoSolutions currently trains the Army's premier CBRNE organization known as Technical Escort (TE) here at Ft. Lewis WA. I am trying to put together facility tours of various Seattle biotech firms so that the soldiers who are charged with these difficult missions are as prepared as they can be and have some exposure to true biological research and production facilities.
